## Timeline for PFAS on Whidbey Island

Date	Event
2016	Navy starts drinking water investigation around Ault Field and OLF
2018	WIWSA represented on DOE/DOH PFAS CAP Advisory Committee
2020	DOH/DOE release Draft PFAS CAP. Recommends drinking water limits
2021	DOH adopts standards for PFAS in drinking water in Washington (SALs) DOE/DOH releases final PFAS CAP
2022	DOE recommends PFAS cleanup levels for soil and groundwater in Washington EPA issues new Lifetime Health Advisories for PFAS in drinking water Voluntary testing of water systems on Whidbey Island shows 13/137 water systems with detections EPA proposes CERCLA listing for PFAS WIWSA represented on DOH PFAS Stakeholder forum
