Theme of this meeting: Island County Hydrogeological Data

Chris Kelley, Island County Hydrogeologist

Chris discussed history of database under Doug Kelly, starting with 300

wells for sea level rise, who put together a database in Access.

Now 32-bit Access is no longer available, the database is using too much server space, and there are no county staff for maintenance. There are 9000 wells in the system and a correspondingly large number of pdfs in the system.

Chris is working to get the backlog of wells into the system, with another 250 to go. The database will be migrated to SQL Server/HTML.

Chris noted the database does not fulfill water systems' record retention requirements.

New data will be added as available.

Chris showed us the IC Web Site for groundwater data and gave us an overview of new system which was impressive.
